4. Recommendation letter #1 File Upload must be a PDF
5. Recommendation letter #2 File Upload must be a PDF
6. Option to send an individual an email request for recommendation

6. Tell us about the barriers you anticipate in college and your plan to address them?
7. What does success look like to you after college?

9. Social justice impacts our world every day. Share the motivation for your involvement in the community around social justice issue(s).
