

ant to see how the Multnomah Athletic Foundation uses the funds it raises every year? You don't need to look far.

You can find it in a Portland high school, where the Foundation's scholarship funding has the flexibility to support technology, fees, and books, so a student athlete can buy a new laptop before they go to college. It's at the local little league, where MAF purchased gloves for underserved kids who could not otherwise be able to play baseball. It's on the youth soccer pitch, where the Foundation supplied new cleats and safety equipment for a program. It's at after-school programs, where the foundation's financial support helps organizations provide food boxes and healthy snacks for kids.

These donations—\$246,000 in 2022 alone—make up what the Foundation calls vital funds. It's money that helps youth and student athletes throughout the Portland area with immediate needs, and without them, some kids might have been sitting out for a season this year.

"Bike First! thrived in our 2022 clinic thanks to the support of our community and grantors," says Ann Donaca, Director


of *Bike First!*. "We bring together children who can benefit from learning cycling skills with volunteers that believe they can make a difference—and they do. MAF has been a big supporter and has helped get many riders on the road!"

Of course, the Foundation does more than buy cleats and gloves. It also awarded 55 scholarships, totaling over \$131,000, that helped send kids to 36 different universities and community colleges. The Foundation also funded grants for 22 local nonprofit organizations in the community, something it does each year.

The Foundation is actively working to raise funds in a variety of ways to be invested in the broader community. Simply put, MAF gives for impact, finding avenues that will make an immediate difference in the lives of young people across the region.
