Eligibility Questions:

Which Scholarship(s) are you applying for?

1. Are you planning to enroll in an accredited institution or accredited trade school or certified professional development program during the upcoming fall? 2-year, 4-year, graduate level degree or trade school certificate or certified professional development programs are eligible.
2. Can you demonstrate financial need to further your education and training?
3. If currently enrolled academically, do you have a minimum unweighted 2.50 GPA on a 4.0 Scale?
4. Are you an employee of the Multnomah Athletic Club with a minimum of 12 consecutive months of service as of December 1, 2024 (or a dependent of a MAC employee who has been employed at least one year as of December 1, 2024)?
5. Are you engaged in civic involvement that demonstrates leadership in your school or community activities?
6. Are you eligible based on the guidelines utilized by the U.S. Department of Education for Federal Financial Aid eligibility (U.S. Citizens, U.S. Nationals, U.S. Permanent Residents, Refugees or Humanitarian Parolees)?

If you answered NO to any of the eligibility questions, be advised that you may not be a strong candidate for consideration of the scholarship. Please review the eligibility questions before you continue to ensure this opportunity is a good investment of your time and energy.

4. Recommendation letter #1. File Upload must be a PDF
5. Recommendation letter #2. File Upload must be a PDF
6. Option to send an individual an email request for recommendation

3. Tell us about your prior and current work experience. Then, explain one experience that is meaningful to you and what you have learned.
4. Tell us about your educational and personal goals.
5. How do you intend (or are currently) paying for your college education? Please elaborate.
6. Tell us about the challenges you anticipate in college and your plan to address them.
7. What does success look like to you?
8. Diversity, equity, inclusion and belonging are essential for communities to thrive. How do you help others feel seen, supported, and valued?
